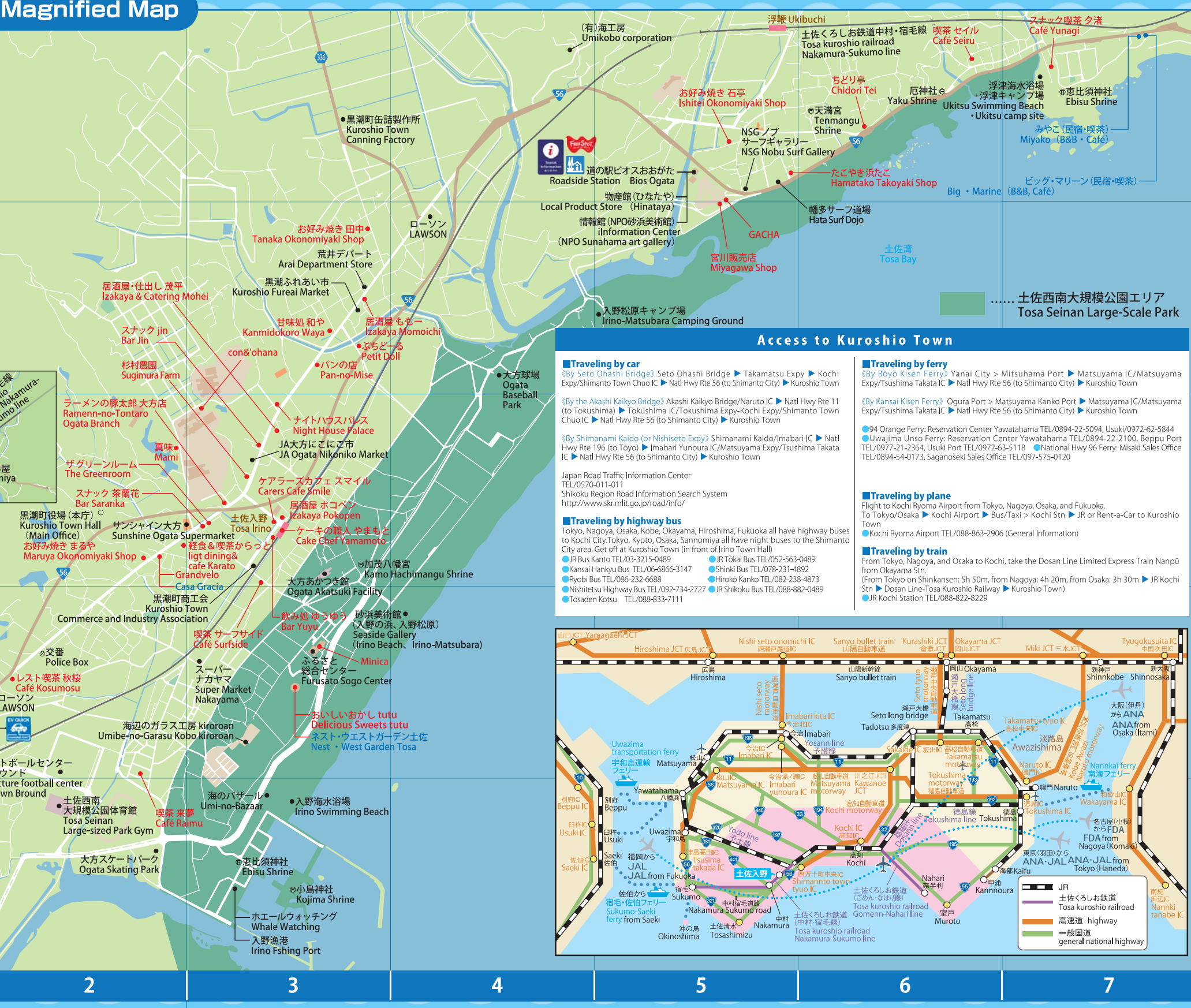

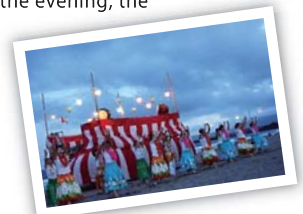

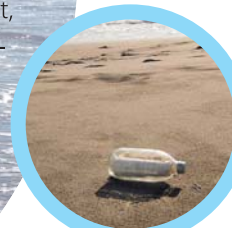

When you picture an art museum, isn't the first thing that comes to mind probably a beautiful grand building? However, the 4 kilometer length of the Irino beach serves as the art museum for Kuroshio Town's Seaside Gallery. The scenery we'd taken for granted each day is now seen as a piece of artwork. For example, the "Nitari Kujira" (Bryde's whale) swimming offshore, the "Rakkyo Flower Fields" spread across the sandy shores, the "Driftage" that arrives on the beach, the "Ripple Mark" designs made on the sand by the waves and wind, and the "Matsubara" (pine grove) welcoming the salt breeze... All of these are "works of art" to us. Bathed in moonlight, the waves lap like music by the Seaside Gallery. These art pieces co-exist with the abundant nature and are on display 24 hours a day, 365 days a year, presenting the various expressions of the seasons and passage of time to those who visit. The "Seaside Gallery" is a place where you can take what you ordinarily experience and, with a little change in perspective and work of the imagination, develop your senses.

Akaumigame (loggerhead turtle)



During June through August, loggerhead turtles come to the beach to lay their eggs. At dawn, you can see the unique footprints they leave behind.

Mairuka (common dolphin)



The name comes from the "ma" in "masani tenkeiteki" (quite typical) and "iruka" (dolphin). Whale watching is also possible.

Shiro-chidori (Kentish plover)



Check for these cute birds chasing each other across the shore and sticking their heads in the sand for food.

Kashima



This small island floating in Saga's cove can be counted as one of Hata's ten most beautiful scenes.

Driftage



Seashells, agricultural containers which make you think of environmental problems, and driftwood carved into "natural sculptures" collect from around the world.

Myojinmaru's straw-seared bonito has ranked first overall for Kochi Prefecture's popularity event, the 2014 Kochi-ke Dining Prefectural General Election, and at this roadside station, you can enjoy their famed "straw-seared bonito." There's a medley of different bonito dishes to try from at their restaurant such as the

Bonito Set, Bonito Rice Bowl, Bonito Curry Rice, and Bonito Burger! Economical breakfast sets are also served in the morning. In the goods corner, you can find an assortment of local specialties and fresh produce. There are also freshly-made lunch boxes and bread so make sure to stop by!

The intense hot heat that comes from straw-searing brings out the umami flavor of the bonito that goes well with salt or sauce.



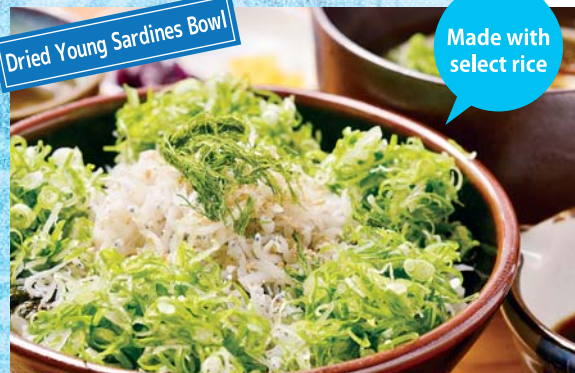

The blessings of the Kuroshio flowing in from surrounding areas of the Tosa Bay, skilled fishermen who fish for bonito one by one with the eco-friendly pole-and line fishing method, and the fishing port's daily hauls are a crucial part of Kuroshio Town's dining culture. Kuroshio Town's sun-dried salt is another reason why the "salted seared bonito" is so delicious.

Tosa Saga no Himodori Bonito

Bonito is good for you!

Here are the results from a one-year study held from July 2008 to July 2009 during which Kochi University and Kuroshio Town collaborated to find the components found in Tosa Saga no Himodori Bonito.

Carnosine
(73.3mg/100g)

Is reported to be effective in lessening fatigue and increasing mobility when taken with anserine.

Anserine
(258mg/100g)

Is reported to be effective in lessening fatigue and increasing mobility when taken with carnosine. Also said to decrease levels of uric acid.

Histidine
(892mg/100g)

Acts as an appetite suppressant and is said to be good for diets.

Eating it with other condiments such as garlic will increase your nutrition intake!

In March 2012, the Kuroshio Town area was predicted to have Japan's highest tsunami at 34 meters high in the event of the Nankai (South Pacific) Truff Large-Scale Earthquake. However, since the prediction, the town has been working with its citizens to keep "casualties at zero" and create new plans. They have focused attention on "canned foods" in case of evacuation, which can be preserved to have ready at homes and in the town by establishing the Kuroshio Town Canning Facility on March 11th, 2014. Using local gourmet ingredients, the food is canned to make emergency rations that you would want to eat every day. They are also consuming what they make so as to keep food from going bad, creating a rolling stock (continuous restock) of canned goods.
