School History & Information

The Foundation of MEF Schools and the Stages of Establishment:

We are all aware of the fact that the most important way to keep pace with this constantly changing and developing time is "education". It is very important for us that our students will learn how to learn and will take pleasure in learning. At the start of our educational journey, our aim was to create a strong foundation for our students' constantly changing educational needs. Prior to the establishment of our school, we analysed and evaluated the educational systems in various countries. Then we prepared feasibility studies followed by a development plan and curriculum; and finally our education program was started.

MEF Schools started its first academic year in 1996 with its kindergarten, primary school and high school students. In 1998, MEF International School opened serving the international community.

With the approval of the Turkish Ministry of Education, MEF High School became a project school and a four year high school.

- In the academic year 2004-2005, MEF International School in Izmir opened.
- In the academic year 2008-2009, MEF Bahçeşehir Schools opened.
- In the academic year 2014-2015, MEF University opened.

Our school's main campus in Ulus is centrally located just above Ortakoy, built on a 40 acre lot with multipurpose facilities, only minutes away from the Bosphorus Straits and residential locations preferred by the expatriate community.

The languages of instruction (Turkish and English) are complemented by other languages (French, German and Spanish).

Curriculum Description

The academic program is bilingual with a university preparatory curriculum. English is the language of instruction for science, math and English literature courses as well as a variety of electives. Turkish is the language of instruction for Turkish language and literature and social science courses.

Students follow a common core curriculum, consisting of English, Turkish literature and language, maths, sciences, social sciences, a secondary foreign language, and electives. It is required that students planning to study science, maths, or engineering complete 4 years of maths and science. Students take an average of 12 courses per year, including electives.

The International Baccalaureate Diploma Program is a rigorous pre-university course of studies leading to examinations that meets the needs of highly motivated secondary school students. Designed as a comprehensive two-year curriculum, the diploma model incorporates the best elements of various educational systems.

At MEF National High School the passing grade for examinations is 50% as illustrated in the following table:

Extracurricular Activities

Students are involved in a wide range of activities and organizations. They are active participants in Model United Nations (MUN). They participated in a special EU Comenius Project supported by the European Union entitled "H2O-Not Only Water" that aimed to increase awareness on the importance of water for our planet. MEF School has been organizing "The Research Projects Contest" among high school level students for twenty-one years in order to support science education in Turkey and in order to motivate the students who are capable in this area to perform scientific research and enable them to aspire to be the "Scientists of the Future". Students of high schools from Turkey and abroad are invited to take part in the contest.

Since the beginning of the 2015-2016 academic year our school has been a partner in a project entitled The Innovative Schools Network (ISN) 2030. It is a two-year successor educational project of the OECD Tohoku School which applies "active learning" in the global context, including project-based learning, inquiry-based learning, and challenge learning as its framework. The project aims to develop creative community models by leveraging the power of students and their fresh creative and innovative minds.

MEF High School Students take part in a prestigious competition organized by TÜBİTAK (The Scientific and Technological Research Council of Turkey) nationwide every year.

In 2014, in the 22nd International First Step to Nobel Prize Physics contest organized in Poland, our High School grade 12 student **İlayda ŞAMİLGİL** was awarded the "Honour Award" with her project entitled **"A Cheap, Fast and Portable System for Computing Water Percentage of Liquids by using Magnets".**

As a result of the second and the final evaluations, our student's project was awarded first place.

In 'Dis-moi dix mots 2016, a competition involving over 1000 projects from 26 different countries organized by the French Ministry of Education and supported by the French Ministry of Cultural Affairs and the French Ministry of Foreign Affairs, our school's project, prepared by four students in the 11th grade under the supervision of their French teacher, was awarded first prize.

In the 8th International Folk Dancing Competition 2016 in Italy, Rimini, our dancing group was awarded first place

Our school, in collaboration with MEF University, offers its students a 10-week-student personal development programme, which is the first of its kind in Turkey.
